The Loading dock is available for short term use (Maximum 1 hour)

There is no overnight docking at the Club unless arranged with the Club. A charge may apply.

The use of the shower and washroom facilities, and garbage disposal (use the Dumpster please) is provided

A Temporary or Social Membership in the Club provides the full use of the Clubhouse facilities (lounges and bar), and participation in our summer sailing program (races or cruises)

Dinghies can be tied up to the shore dock to the shore dock at the North end of the yard. Use of the dry dinghy storage area is available for Club Members for a fee.

The maximum boat length on the moorings is 42 ft. Any larger boat must be arranged with the Yacht Services Director.
